

SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. <u>All Rules as per the 2025 BSPS Rule & Show Handbook. See BSPS website for any amendments and helpful information.</u> <u>www.bsps.com</u>
- 2) Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.
- It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate Indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.
- * NEW You accept being around horses & riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. You may fall off and could be injured, or be injured by another horse. By entering you accept these risks. It is advisable you take out your own Personal Accident Insurance to cover you against the risk of injury.
- 3) All horses and ponies must be four years old or over. *NOTE No animal can be brought onto the showground unless it is entered in a class within this schedule *
- 4) This is a qualifying show for the BSPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW to be held on 19th 23rd August 2025 at Arena UK, Allington Lane, Allington, Grantham, Lincs. NG322EF
- <u>5) QUALIFICATION FOR THE B.S.P.S. SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW</u> The 1st and 2nd placed animals in classes **7**, **37** & **38**. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes **6** & **46** The 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th in mixed classes **4**, **41** & **45** will qualify for the BSPS Championship Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.
- <u>6) NEW "THE BSPS SHOWMAN'S AWARD"</u> The final will be held at the 2025 BSPS Summer Championship Show, on the Thursday evening, in the Topspec Arena. To be eligible for qualification, riders 25yrs and under, excluding first ridden and lead rein and must be a member of BSPS AREA 15 to compete. See rule 413 in the BSPS 2025 rule book. The final is free to enter.
- 7) THE BSPS "THOR ATKINSON STEEL FABRICATIONS LTD CHALLENGE" This show is a qualifier for this BSPS Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify: Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SRT, SH & WH, and Open Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. Classes 4, 6, 7, 14, 28, 29, 33, 37, 38, 41, 42, 45 & 46
- 8) <u>THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS</u> This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The Binks Family Champion Of Champions. <u>The 1st prize winners</u> in the following classes will qualify-Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT, & WH, Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes. <u>8b) THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS.</u> This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The Binks Family Mini WHP Champion Of Champions. <u>The 1st prize winners</u> in Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify.
- 9) BSPS RULES- Riders must be 12 years old and over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony

stallion not exc. 138cms or Small Breed M&M Stallions i.e. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B. Riders must be 14 years old and over on 1st January in the current year to ride any Stallion exc. 138cms or Large Breed M&M Stallions i.e. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D.

- 10) HATS AS PER RULE 43 IN THE 2025 RULE BOOK Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats nos. PAS015 2011,VGI,(BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 & E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006 MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green, velvet covers are encouraged. The BSPS encourages members to have their hats tagged through the BSPS scheme or via the Pony Club scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards. No check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they compete. Hat tagging in BSPS classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championship shows, RIHS, LIHS, Burghley Gold Cup & Lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Cub & Pony Club tags.)
- 11) BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE COMPLIANT WITH RULE 50 IN THE 2025 BSPS RULE BOOK They must be worn when jumping in any WHP & WH classes, including in the practice ring at B.S.P.S. affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes.) Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practise jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. A BETA approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on lable. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are NOT allowed, except with medical dispensation.

12) Only tack that is permissible in the ring in BSPS classes is allowed to be used on the showground when mounted.

- 13) This Show is run with due regard to Health and Safety. The primary contact on the day will be Mr. Chris Yates. It is in the best interests of all exhibitors and spectators that they comply with any request, verbal or written, from any Show Official which pertains to Health and Safety matters. Any accident must be reported to a Show Official as soon as possible. First Aiders/ Medics will be on duty for all classes.
- **14)** Animals may not compete in both the 153cms WHP Class and the Intermediate WH class at the same show, in the same section, except at the RIHS.
- <u>THIS SHOW IS AFFILIATED TO EQUIFEST</u> Taking place at Arena UK on 6th 9th August 2025 The two highest placed exhibits, not already qualified in each affiliated class, will qualify. **Please download qualification cards from Equifest www.equifest.org.uk.**

The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes WHP classes. (Classes 1, 2, 5 & 12) These classes are Open to Plaited Animals and Heritage (M&M) Ponies

Animals may be entered in more than one class in this section. <u>Method of Judging</u> - animals will be required to jump a course of fences, they will immediately be asked to give a short show including a change of rein and gallop in the same ring. Marks:- Jumping 60 points, Style & Manners while jumping 20 points, Show mark & Manners 20points. TOTAL 100 points. Ponies may not be shown on the Lead Rein. Any Suitable Tack.

Class 1 The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes Animals 4yrs or over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 70cms

Class 2 The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes Animals 4yrs and over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 80cms

Class 3 The B.S.P.S. Mixed Height Novice WHP/Intermediate W.H. Mare or gelding 4 yrs. or over not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. NEW - riders may ride two ponies in the same height section (see rule 37). Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or the Intermediate Section.

Small height ponies will jump first. <u>Please state height of pony on entry form.</u> (Please note Area 15 WHP championship following class 4)

Class 4 The B.S.P.S. Mixed Height Open WHP/Intermediate W.H. Mare or gelding, 4 yrs or and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride.

<u>NEW</u> - riders may ride two ponies in same height section. (see rule 37) Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or the Intermediate Section. Large height ponies will jump first. <u>Please state height of pony on entry form</u>

(Please note- Area 15 WHP championship that follows class 4)

The WINNER of class 4 will qualify for The BSPS The Binks Family Champion of Champions

AREA 15 WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the two highest placed ponies, owned and ridden by a member of AREA 15 and wearing a white armband from the Mixed height NOVICE class 3 and the Mixed height OPEN class 4. Champion will receive the "WHP Challenge Cup" presented by the

late Mr T. Hunnable & the late Mrs E. Hunnable-Schnieder and receive A **SASH**, kindly sponsored by **MICHELLE HUTLEY**

Class 5 The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes Animals 4yrs and over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 50cms (see above rules)

Class 6 The B.S.P.S. Cradle Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 123 cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Rosettes to all.

(Area 15 Mini WHP Championship follows after class 11)

Class 7 The B.S.P.S. Open Nursery Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

The winners of classes 6-7 will qualify for The BSPS The Binks Family Mini Champion of Champions NOTE - (Area 15 Mini WHP Championship follows class 11)

Class 8 <u>Unaffiliated Leading Rein WHP</u> Mare or gelding 4 yrs or over, not exceeding <u>123</u> <u>cms.</u> Open to plaited or unplaited. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Pony to be lead only from the noseband by a leader 16 years or over. A very low and short course, to encourage and introduce the child into whp classes. Rosettes to all.

Class 9 <u>B.S.P.S. Tiny Tots Stakes</u> Mare or gelding 4 yrs. or over, not exc. <u>123 cms.</u> Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. <u>Open to Ponies plaited or unplaited</u>. Maximum height and spread of fences 40 cms. Rosettes to all competitors. <u>Area 15 Championship to follow class 11</u>

- Class 10 The B.S.P.S. Heritage M&M Open Cradle Stakes. Registered pure bred ponies, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Rosettes to all.
- Class 11 <u>The B.S.P.S. Heritage M&M Open Nursery Stakes.</u> Registered pure bred ponies, 4 years old or over not exceeding <u>133cms</u> Riders not to have attained their <u>13th birthday</u> before the lst. January in the current year.
- (A) <u>THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE OPEN MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP</u>. The 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 10 & 11 qualify. **Rosettes kindly sponsored by <u>B.H.E. METAL</u> RECYCLING**
- **(B)** <u>AREA 15 MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP</u>. Open to the 2 highest placed ponies, owned and ridden by a member of Area 15, <u>wearing a white armband</u>, in classes 6, 7, 9, 10 &11 Champion to receive the "<u>KINGS RED KITE" SHIELD</u> presented by the Flynn Family and a SASH, kindly sponsored by <u>B.H.E. METAL RECYCLING</u>
- Class 12 <u>The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes</u> Animals 4 yrs and over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 60 cms (See rules before class one)
- Class 13 The B.S.P.S. Heritage M & M Novice Mixed Height WHP. Registered Pure Bred Ponies, 4 years old or over, riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Starting with the <u>small</u> height ponies first. <u>Please state height of pony on entry form.</u> - Please note Area 15 championship after class14)

Class 14 The BSPS Heritage M & M Open Mixed Height WHP Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. Starting with the <u>large</u> height ponies first. Please state height of pony on entry form. Note <u>Area 15 championship follows.</u>

The winner of class 14 will qualify for the BSPS The Binks Family Champion of Champions.

AREA 15 HERITAGE M&M WHP CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to the 2 highest placed ponies, owned and ridden by a member of Area 15, wearing a white armband, in classes 13 (Mixed Height Novice) &14 (Mixed Height Open) Champion to receive a SASH, kindly sponsored by SANDCREST WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Class 15 Unaffiliated Walk and Trot Class – NO STALLIONS

Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over. Not exceeding 148 cms Riders suitably mounted. May be shown in any suitable bridle. This class is aimed at getting newcomers, new combinations or young ponies into the ring. Will not be judged on conformation.

* In all the following TSR Amateur classes, 16,17, 21, 22, 23, 24 & 25 exhibits do not need to be a member to qualify. – TSR membership will be required for them to compete in the final. {These classes are also qualifers for EQUIFEST}

Class 16 <u>NEW – TSR - M & M Large Breeds Ridden Amateur of the Year</u> Open to M&M ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Fell, Dales, Highlands, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh C & Welsh D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs or over. Rider any age.

Class 17 <u>NEW – TSR - M & M Small Breeds Ridden Amateur of the Year</u> Open to M&M ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs or over. Rider any age but suitably mounted.

* Classes 18,19 & 20 are NOT qualifying classes

Class 18 The BSPS Pretty Polly Mixed Breeds Heritage Ridden. Reg. pure bred ponies, 4yrs.old or over. Riders any age, subject to show schedule rule 9

Class 19 <u>The BSPS Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony.</u> Mare or Gelding, 4 yrs. old or over, not exc. 148cms. Riders on ponies not exc.128cms must not have attained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Riders on ponies exc.128cms.must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 20 The BSPS Pretty Polly Mixed height S.H.P. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Ponies not exc.133 cms. riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies exc.133cms but not exc.153cms. riders must not have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

AREA 15 PRETTY POLLY CHAMPIONSHIP Open to the 2 highest placed ponies owned and ridden by a member of Area 15, wearing a white armband, in classes 18,19 & 20 Champion to receive the "PARADIGM CHALLENGE CUP" presented by MRS. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Rosettes to all competitors.

Class 22 NEW – TSR- First Ridden M&M Ridden Amateur of the Year

Open to M&M ponies registered with their pure bred societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 yrs. old or over, not exceeding 128cms. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider not have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Rosettes to all competitors.

Class 23 NEW - TSR - Lead Rein Plaited Amateur of the Year

Lead rein pony, mare or gelding, 4yrs old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the currant year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all competitors.

Class 24 NEW - TSR- First Ridden Plaited Amateur of the Year

First ridden pony, mare or gelding, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bridle.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. May be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all competitors. Following class 30 - The two highest placed Area 15 members go forward to the Area 15 Mini M&M Championship.
